Cathedral of Saint Paul opens doors during Red Bull Crashed Ice

(Saint Paul, MN) While the world watches the action-packed Red Bull Crashed Ice event, spectators are invited inside the Cathedral of Saint Paul to warm up and take in the historic beauty. This year marks the fourth consecutive year Red Bull Crashed Ice has staged its international competition over the front steps of the Cathedral, located at 239 Selby Avenue, at the intersection of Summit Avenue, near downtown Saint Paul.

The main event takes place on Saturday, January 24th, with practice runs and elimination rounds taking place Jan. 22 and 23rd.

The Cathedral's side doors will be open for the duration of the events on both Friday and Saturday evenings. Doors are located along both the Selby and Dayton Avenues, with handicapped entrances available on both sides.

Visitors are also welcome to preview a new photo exhibit, *A Timeline of Cathedral History*, making its official debut on Sunday, Jan. 25th following the 10 a.m. Mass to mark the start of Centennial – 2015. The exhibit is displayed on the lower level of the Cathedral across from the Welcome Center. The Cathedral Museum, also on the lower level, will be open to visitors.
