Select a tree that stands 8-feet or less in the stand (to ensure it fits in our delivery truck standing up.)

Decorate your tree in a festive theme of your choosing (no glass please).

Be ready for pick-up at 8:30 a.m., Tuesday, Dec. 14. Volunteers from the Cathedral will pick up your tree and deliver it to the courtyard for display.

Use lights—lots of lights – to show off your decorations in the dark winter night. Tie a colorful ribbon over the end of your light string to make it easy for us to find!

Invite your parish, school, community to show up and VOTE!! All proceeds help us preserve and restore our Cathedral.

Tokens for voting will be available for purchase at the Christmas Market. 6-10 p.m., Thursday, Friday, and Saturday.

The winning tree will be announced Sunday evening at the Cathedral by Archbishop Bernard Hebda.
